



Basic Crochet Hat

But very stylish

One ball of each of 4 colours of
Mission Falls 1824 Wool

Colours used in our hat:

- 1 – Basil #0532
- 2 – Squash #0533
- 3 – Teal #030
- 4 – Earth #008

5mm crochet hook

While teaching "Learn To Crochet" at Spun Fibre Arts, one of the most common requests is "can I make a hat". When searching for an easy-to-read pattern proved more difficult than I had anticipated, I decided to create one myself and use an easy-to-use yarn.

I love Mission Falls 1824 Wool. The colours are rich and the wool is extremely soft. Top it all off with its ability to be machine washed and dried, and it is a perfect yarn for hats. Feel free to play with the colour combinations, or just choose your favourite and make it all one colour!

Size: average adult-sized head, with the option to reduce the length length for more traditional hat (ie Fasten off after Round 32)

Notes: the 'cleanest' way to change colours is to do it in the slip stitch from the previous row, right before starting the row with the new colour

Pattern:

With colour 1, Chain 2

In the second chain from the hook, work 8 sc in the same space. Slip stitch into the first sc to close the round. Ch 1.

Round 1 – 2 sc in each sc in the round (16 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 2 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next sc) repeat () to end of round (24 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 3 - (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc) repeat () to end of round (32 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 4 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc) repeat () to end of round (40 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 5 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 4 sc) repeat () to end of round (48 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 6 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 5 sc) repeat () to end of round (56 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 7 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 6 sc) repeat () to end of round (64 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 2

Round 8 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 7 sc) repeat () to end of round (72 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 9 – (2 sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 8 sc) repeat () to end of round (80 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 3

Round 10 - (2 sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 9 sc) repeat () to end of round (88 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Rounds 11-12 – 1 sc in each sc in the round (88 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Round 13 – (2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 10sc) repeat () to end of round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 1

Rounds 14-15 – 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 4

Rounds 16-21 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 2

Rounds 22-24 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 3

Round 25 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 1

Rounds 26-30 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 4

Rounds 30-32 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 3

Rounds 33-38 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 2

Rounds 39-40 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Change to colour 4

Rounds 41-43 - 1 sc in each sc in the round (96 sts). Slip stitch into 1st sc and ch 1.

Fasten off.
